This is not a CD-ROM. There is no presentation program to launch or software to install.

### Before using this CD

### What software do I need?

Adobe® Acrobat Reader® (version 4.0 or greater) must be installed on your computer in order to access the discussion guides (.pdf format). If Acrobat Reader is not installed, you can download it for free at:

The picture files are JPEG files (.jpg format). They can be opened by virtually any image processing software, including the standard software included in your computer's operating system (Windows, MacOS, Linux).

The movie files are QuickTime movies (.mov format). They can be played by most movie player programs. If you cannot open and play the movie files, please download QuickTime Player for free at:

### Finding files

Two files (located in the START HERE folder) will help you find the files or media examples you're looking for:

- "File list" is a complete list of files and folders on the CD.
- "Media examples" is a complete list of media examples, arranged by folder.

### Display

The pictures and movies are formatted for display at a monitor resolution of 640 x 480. If the pictures or movies appear too small on your monitor, try setting your monitor resolution at 640 x 480.

Your picture viewing software may also allow you to increase the size of the image. Look under "View" in the menu bar.

### Movies

If the QuickTime movies do not play smoothly:

- Turn off your virus protection software.
- Check your video settings and reduce the frame rate if necessary.
- If you have an older computer with a slower CD-ROM drive, try copying the movies to your hard drive and playing them from there.

### Printing

To print the discussion guides, open them with Adobe Acrobat Reader and choose File/Print from the menu bar.
